## M3P Quickie - Creating a new Page in M3P from scratch

Starting a Page on a new subject is easy. However, it is encouraged to first check if a title page on your subject already exists on M3P. This is easily done by typing the title of your page in the **SEARCH** box (left-hand side) and click on the **SEARCH** button. If your search is found, it means that a page already exits.

STEP 1	Log in at www.m3p.com.mt

STEP 3	Click on the SEARCH button. This will take you to the Search Results page.  Here you can check for any pages that already exist on the subject you plan to write about, or that have the same title. Try changing your title a little, for example, adding a date to it.
